The Trainer STEVE WHITE informed stewards that he did not apply at the kennels due to the greyhound wearing a Thermal Rug to the boxes. Stewards informed the trainer that this practice will not be acceptable to Stewards and the Canberra Club and should not happen again, the incident will be noted.

RACE 10	READY 4 PLUMBING AFTER HOURS 4/5 GRADE 530M		
INCIDENTS	(7)TILLY'S WISH slow from the boxes. (4)BONNIE HENRY and (5) TWITTER ME came together at the first turn. The Connections of (2) ELITE DOS Sydney Swain was interviewed regarding the delay in getting the greyhound in the boxes. He stated that he had trouble getting the collar off the greyhound. The starter conferred this incident. Trainer of (7)TILLY'S WISH was interviewed regarding the hitting the top of starting boxes. MR KEN STAINES defended his actions due to the delay with (2) ELITE DOS being boxed. Stewards informed the trainer that under no circumstances is a handler allowed to hit the boxes and this would be noted in his report. Stewards directed that KEN STAINES step back away from the boxes when he has boxed his competitor. It was been noted in previous races MR STAINES remains in close proximity to the starting boxes, which is unacceptable to Stewards as this may impede the Starters actions. Stewards also informed MR STAINES that his actions in this regard will be monitored in the future. Stewards also interviewed the Starter of this event in relation to him calling competitors to box for the event. Stewards directed the Starter that vigilance is needed, making sure that all 'leads and collars are off' prior to greyhounds being asked to box.
